Before you bring your items

1. Please consider

- Selling them (Facebook Marketplace)
- Rehoming them (Freecycle/Trash nothing)
- Donating them to charity
- Getting them repaired at a local repair shop:
Folkestone Sunflower House
Ashford Repair Café at Singleton

2. Remove any batteries if it is easy to do so

3. With phones or computers, back up your data, remove SIM or other cards, then delete your data. Scan the QR code below for help.

What happens to your items?

They will be picked up and taken to SWEEEP, the state-of-the-art recycling facility at Sittingbourne. There they are safely processed and 75% of the material will be recovered and made available to manufacturers for creation of useful products such as children's playground equipment or lifesaving medical apparatus. Go Folkestone may use local charity shops and repair centres. It will remove items e.g. mobile phones, for separate treatment.

All precious metals will be recovered for re-use, avoiding the mining of virgin materials and depletion of the earth's resources.

Anything with a plug, battery or cable
can be re-used or recycled.
